INTRODUCTION

This DG Shipping approved preparatory course is meant to cover part of the education and training required under Regulation II/1 and aims to meet the standards of competence specified in Section A-II/1 of the STCW 78 as amended.

Appendix M-II/1 of META Manual Vol. II and IMO Model course 7.03 is the basis of the course content.

OBJECTIVE

The foremost objective of this course is to prepare a candidate to appear for the examinations of Second Mate of the Certificate of Competency of a Foreign Going Ship.

To impart knowledge and training in a way which is best suited to individual requirements, enabling candidates to successfully pass the Second Mate (F.G) Examination conducted by D.G. Shipping.

The said preparation is strictly in accordance with the Syllabi & the Guidelines contained in the META manual of the DG Shipping, Govt. of India and conform to the levels of competence as outlined in the STCW 1995 Code as amended in 2010.
